

## PIEMONTE DOC BONARDA

Doop rod slightly grisp
Deep red, slightly crisp.
Persistent, with hints of well-rip fruit.
Full-bodied and complex, though delicate.
A demanding wine that deserves to be served with exquisite, light dishes.
20 – 22°C
The Bonarda grape is grown in Piedmont in just a few areas where soil conditions are fair.
Where these soil requirements are met, the Bonarda vine produces high quality grapes, and the resulting wine has unique organoleptic characteristics.

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
